SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

These supplemental Sailing Instructions are issued in accordance with Club SI 11.3.

2. THE START

2.1 The start time indicated in the Year Book is the start time for Mirrors with gaff rigs and both helmsman AND crew ('traditional Mirrors').

2.2 The start times for other boats are as set out below:

Class / fleet captains may apply individual handicaps to members of their fleets. Such handicaps may permit individual boats to start one, two or three minutes prior to the start time specified for their boat in the table above. Individual handicaps must be notified to the Officer of the Day prior to the display of the Warning Signal.

2.3 Sound signals will be made for the Warning Signal, the Preparatory Signal and the start for the traditional Mirrors.

2.4 Any boat that starts before its allotted start time will be scored DNS without a hearing. A boat may start after its allotted start time, but any boat that starts later than 3 minutes after the allotted start time of the last boat to start will be scored DNS without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.
